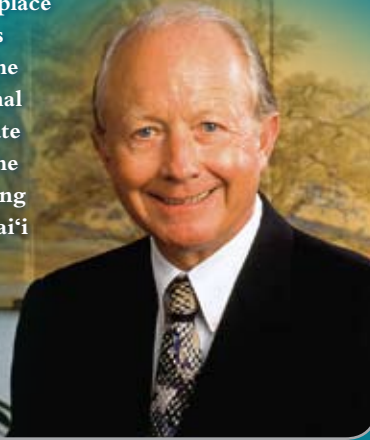

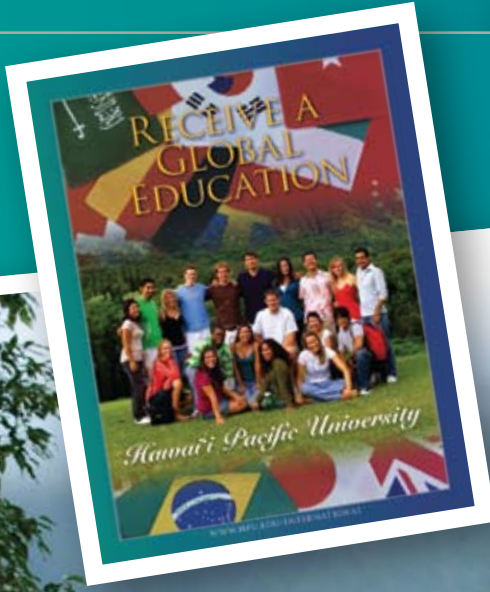

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SERVICES

We have many years of experience servicing the needs of international students. From the International Center and the English Foundations Program to the many country-specific student organizations, HPU bridges the gap between countries and cultures to make everyone's experience as enriching as possible.

- **Assistance with application procedures** and issue of I-20 forms needed to obtain a student visa.
- **Housing assistance:** The student housing office at HPU can help you find accommodations on campus (Residence Halls) and off campus (through independent property management companies).
- **Airport transportation:** HPU offers a free airport transportation service to new students arriving during normal business hours.

- **New student orientation:** Study abroad students arriving for fall and spring semesters are invited to take a campus tour, attend social events with other new students, and get all questions answered about classes and campus life.
- **Academic and personal counseling:** Our staff of trained professionals will provide you with counseling and guidance for every facet of your HPU academic experience.
- **Free tutoring:** HPU provides individualized tutoring assistance to all registered students free of charge at the Tutoring Center.

ACTIVE STUDENT ENVIRONMENT

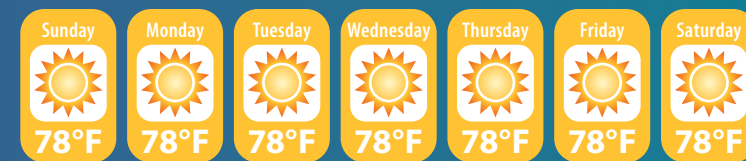
Outside the classroom, students can participate in more than 70 clubs and organizations.

HAWAI'I PACIFIC UNIVERSITY AT A GLANCE...

REPUTATION: OUTSTANDING.

A private, not-for-profit university founded in 1965, HPU is consistently ranked among the best educational institutions in the nation. It is accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Senior Colleges and Universities of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (NLNAC), Inc. The Bachelor of Social Work program is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE). The University is a member of the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB International), recognized by the Hawai'i Commission of Postsecondary Education, and approved by the Hawai'i Board of Nursing.

LOCATION: STUNNING.

Strategically located in the center of the Pacific Rim—the region with the fastest growing economies in the world—HPU provides an American education in an international setting. Cosmopolitan, culturally vibrant, and ethnically diverse, Hawai'i is famous for its clean air and water and a population that enjoys the longest average life expectancy among the 50 states in the nation. In fact, Honolulu was recently ranked one of the safest and cleanest large cities in the United States.

CAMPUS: DISTINCTIVE.

With three campuses linked by shuttle, Hawai'i Pacific University combines the excitement of an urban downtown campus with the serenity of a residential campus set in the green foothills of O'ahu's Ko'olau Mountains. The main campus is located in downtown Honolulu, the business and financial center of the Pacific. Eight miles away, situated on 135 acres in Kane'ohe, the Hawai'i Loa campus is the site of the School of Nursing, the marine science (marine biology and oceanography) and environmental studies programs, and several liberal arts programs. Just steps from the Pacific, HPU's Oceanic Institute offers research and hands-on opportunities.

STUDENT BODY: INCREDIBLE.

More than 7,000 undergraduate and 1,200 graduate students from all 50 U.S. states and from more than 100 countries make HPU one of the most culturally diverse universities in the world. In fact, the student body is roughly split into thirds—one-third from the U.S. mainland and Canada, one-third from Hawai'i and one-third from around the globe.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS: COMPREHENSIVE.

HPU offers more than 40 undergraduate and 12 graduate degree programs in the areas of business administration, communication, and the liberal arts and sciences. Students also may enroll in the University's English language—as well as short-term, non-degree—study programs.

HEALTH AND SAFETY.

Hawai'i is famous for its clean air and water. Among the 50 United States, Hawai'i's people have the longest average life expectancy. Honolulu is ranked one of the safest and cleanest large cities nationally in a recent study of cities in the United States. Furthermore, at HPU we take special care in assuring that our buildings and campuses are safe and comfortable for your successful education.

FACULTY: ACCESSIBLE.

Multicultural, diverse in their interests, and passionate about teaching, HPU faculty are renowned for the personal interest they take in each and every one of their students. HPU boasts of more than 445 full- and part-time faculty from around the world with outstanding academic and business credentials, ensuring that HPU students can easily access a world's worth of knowledge and experiences. A vast majority of HPU faculty hold the highest degree in their fields. The student/faculty ratio is 18:1, and the average class size is less than 25.
