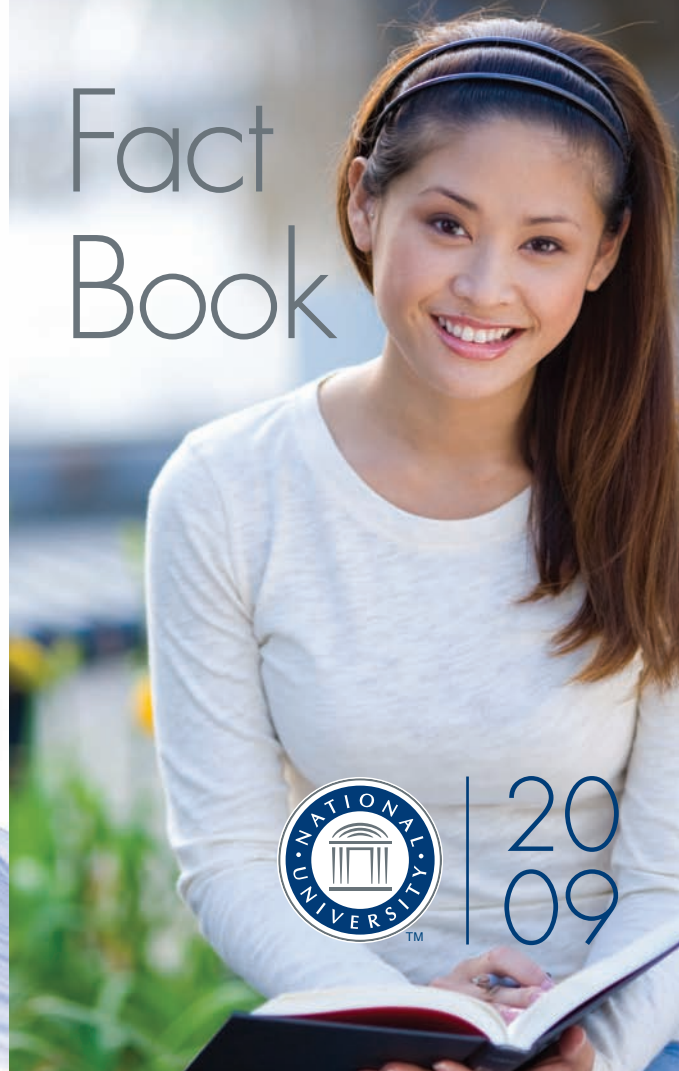

## ▶ About the University

Founded in 1971, National University is the second-largest private, nonprofit institution of higher learning in California. It was among the first to recognize and focus on the unique needs of nontraditional learners. Its distinctive and intensive one-course-per-month format, multiple locations, and onsite and online programs enable students to complete graduate and undergraduate degrees in an accelerated time frame while maintaining family and work responsibilities.

National University is comprised of the College of Letters and Sciences and five schools: Business and Management; Education; Engineering and Technology; Health and Human Services; and Media and Communication.

## ▶ Mission

National University is dedicated to making lifelong learning opportunities accessible, challenging, and relevant to a diverse student population.

National University is the flagship institution of the National University System, which was established in 2001 to meet the emerging demands for education in the 21st century. In addition to National University, the affiliates of the National University System are: John F. Kennedy University; National Polytechnic College of Science; National University Golf Academy; National University International; the Division of Pre-College Programs, consisting of National University Academy and National University Virtual High School; Spectrum Pacific Learning Company LLC; and WestMed College.



### ▶ Convenient Locations

Headquartered in San Diego, National University has 27 campuses in California and Nevada.

The University also operates four Online Information Centers – convenient locations where prospective students can get information about National University and its various degree, credential, and certificate programs; experience online classes; enroll; and get educational counseling and details about financial aid.

### ▶ Year-Round Registration

New courses begin each month, allowing students to enroll at any time.

### ▶ One-Course-Per-Month Format

An intensive, one-course-per-month format creates a concentrated, focused approach. Classes are geared to accommodate the busy schedules of students so they can attend classes in the evenings, weekends, or online. The accelerated format enables students to complete 12 courses per year compared to nine courses at traditional institutions.

### ▶ Streamlined Admissions

Admission is based on previous academic record, professional experience, motivation, and educational objectives. Technology enables prompt online enrollment and processing of transcripts and records. Admissions advisors provide program-specific counseling and assistance from registration through graduation.

### ▶ Student Concierge Services

Student Concierge Services is the student's point of contact for all National University questions. Advocates from Student Concierge Services are available from 7 a.m. to midnight Pacific Time seven days a week to answer a wide range of student questions, from financial aid and admissions to graduation and grades. Technical assistance for students is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

### ▶ Library Resources

The National University Library System has more than 315,000 volumes, including one of the largest e-book collections in the United States. The Library provides access to 87 electronic databases, over 24,000 full text journals, and various services for online users, including Journal Direct, Books Direct, RefDesk e-mail reference, and eReserves.

The National University Library, located in San Diego, includes among its facilities the:

- Curriculum Resource Center, a state-of-the-art classroom supported with K-12 educational

curriculum and software resources used in California schools;

- Career Center, providing face-to-face and online career related services to students, alumni, and the larger university community; and
- Library Instruction Classroom, equipped with 40 networked workstations for learning information literacy skills.



## ▶ Online Programs

National University offers more than 50 programs fully online that incorporate the latest advances in technology to provide a dynamic, interactive learning environment. Students have access to quality education via the Internet, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

## ▶ Technology Resources

Students can access their class schedules, grades, and academic and financial aid information via the student web portal.

More than 60 student computer labs containing over 2,700 PCs are available at National University labs and the library. Web-based video conferencing is available at 26 National University locations.

E-mail, the Internet, e-conferencing, and other multimedia tools are incorporated into National University's on-campus and online courses.

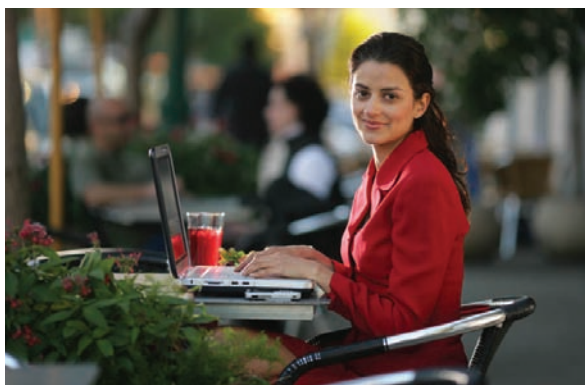
## ▶ Online Features

National University offers unparalleled technical support for online students. Knowledgeable help desk support is available via e-mail or phone 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Faculty members take time to acquaint students with the fundamentals of online learning. They also participate in class discussions, text- and audio-based chats, and fully functional virtual classrooms. Interactive coursework is designed to provide a

balance between content and multimedia presentation so students are fully engaged in the online learning process.

Serving as a single point-of-contact, online advisors assist students from the day they begin their National University program until the time they graduate.

## ▶ An Award-winning Educational Institution

## ▶ Faculty

National University offers a four-tiered faculty structure that has become a model for similar institutions. Full-time and associate faculty add an important theoretical component to the curriculum, while core and adjunct faculty are part-time professors who work in the fields they teach.

Faculty include noted authors and scholars in such diverse disciplines as contemporary fiction, mathematics, technology, film, international business, education, and healthcare.



## ▶ Extended Learning

The Division of Extended Learning offers courses for certificate programs and Continuing Education Units (CEUs) as well as academic credit. Extended Learning provides organizational services to support professional development events such as: certification training, workshops, seminars, and conferences. Offerings may be held at regional centers throughout California, client locations, online, or by real-time web seminars.

Extended Learning provides services to support professional development.

Extended Learning is an Authorized Provider of CEUs in accordance with the International Association of Continuing Education Training (IACET) standards, a hallmark of quality in continuing education and training.

National University is a member of the University Continuing Education Association (UCEA), the Association for Continuing Higher Education (ACHE), the Learning Resources Network (LERN), the American Management Association (AMA), and the National Dropout Prevention Center/Network (NDPC/N).

## ▶ Benefits of Extended Learning

## ▶ Financial Aid and Scholarship Programs

National offers comprehensive guidance and assistance for students seeking financial aid.

Many students receive partial or full tuition reimbursement from their employer.

Talk to a financial aid advisor to learn about the programs available to help you pay for your education.

National University awards tuition scholarships and grants to students who demonstrate exceptional scholastic achievement, to economically disadvantaged students, and to single-parent students with demonstrated financial need.

A variety of scholarships, grants, and loans are available, including:

- Merit Scholarships up to \$2,500 for outstanding academic achievement for undergraduate and graduate students.
- Military Tuition Scholarships up to \$2,500 for eligible military personnel including active duty,

reservists, national guardsmen/women, their spouses, and dependents.

- Community College Transfer Scholarships for students enrolling in National University from the California Community College System.
- The Federal Pell Grant, which awards grants ranging from \$400 to \$4,731.

Many students receive partial or full tuition reimbursement from their employer.

- The Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG), like the Pell, awards grants ranging from \$250 to \$4,000 on a limited basis to students with an exceptional financial need.
- Funded on a limited basis, the Federal Perkins Loans offer low interest loans to students who demonstrate exceptional need.
- Assumption Program of Loans for Education (APLE), whereby the California Student Aid Commission may assume up to \$11,000 in loans for students who commit to teaching in designated public schools.

- The Academic Competitiveness Grant program (ACG), which awards grants ranging from \$47 to \$2,050 for first- and second-year students who have successfully completed a rigorous secondary school program.
- The National SMART Grant, which awards grants ranging from \$250 to \$4,000 for third- and fourth-year PELL eligible students who major in mathematics, science, technology, engineering, or critical foreign languages.
- State aid in the form of Cal Grant A and B, which awards grants ranging from \$100 to \$12,944.
- Federal Stafford Student Loans, which offer students a low fixed interest rate for the life of the loan.
- Federal Plus Loans for Parents is a loan program to assist parents of undergraduate dependent students with educational costs.



- Graduate Plus Loan is a government-insured education loan designed for graduate and professional students.
- Veterans Affairs educational benefits are available to qualifying military personnel.
- Alternative/private educational funding may be available.

Community service is among the six core values of National University.

### ▶ A Commitment to the Community

National University is proud of its dedication to and involvement with the communities it serves. National's commitment to community involves both institutional sponsorships and a unique program that offers employees two days of paid leave during which to provide community service.

### ▶ The National University Community Research Institute (NUCRI)

NUCRI is an entity of the National University System organized to facilitate the University's commitment to a collaborative future as a community partner. The Institute focuses on community research and technology applications for integrated curriculum development, e-learning, capacity building and education outreach, and training. The goal is to broaden participation in the fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields and to facilitate the interface of technology with the humanities, arts, science, social science, and community research.
