Course Structure

The QRC Diploma of Hospitality Management is a two year* full-time course which consists of four on-campus terms and a 9-month internship.

Term 1&2: on-campus (6 months)

Term 3&4: internship (9 months)

Term 5&6: on-campus (6 months)

*There is an early completion opportunity if students complete the required 900 hours of industry training in less time than the prescribed 9 months. Term lengths can vary so please contact the College for more details.
