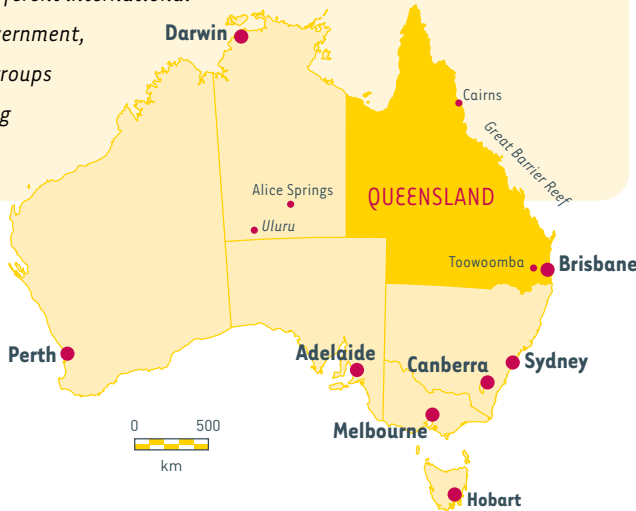
Welcome to USQ

TOOWOOMBA CAMPUS

With a population of approximately 100 000, Toowoomba is Australia's second largest inland city. The beautiful, tree lined city sits on the crest of the Great Dividing Range, around 700 metres above sea level and in the past 10 years has twice been voted Australia's best city to live in. The city has a low cost of living, pleasant surroundings, clean air and a safe, friendly atmosphere.

FRASER COAST CAMPUS

The Bay is a great location for international students, with a superb climate, calm waters, pristine beaches and relaxed yet adventurous lifestyle. Bordered by 40 kilometers of beautiful, calm beaches, Hervey Bay is attracting an increasing number of people to the region. It is famous for the Great Barrier Reef and boasts a magnificent marine environment just perfect for diving, swimming, snorkelling and marine studies. Just offshore lies the World Heritage-listed Fraser Island, which is the largest sand island in the world. A unique natural environment, Fraser Island has natural beaches, rainforests and fresh water lakes - all attractions for eco-tourists from around the globe.

SPRINGFIELD CAMPUS

Springfield is situated in the Brisbane region's south-western corridor 26 km from Brisbane's CBD. USQ Springfield is purpose-built inside an education precinct, known as Education City, which is planned to be Australia's largest learning community. Students at USQ Springfield have access to the very latest in program-specific specialist facilities. Each room on campus is enabled for wireless connectivity, meaning students can access the Internet anywhere, anytime. The campus also features a state-of-the-art auditorium and students have direct access to 24ha parklands and the Orion Greater Springfield shopping and entertainment precinct.
