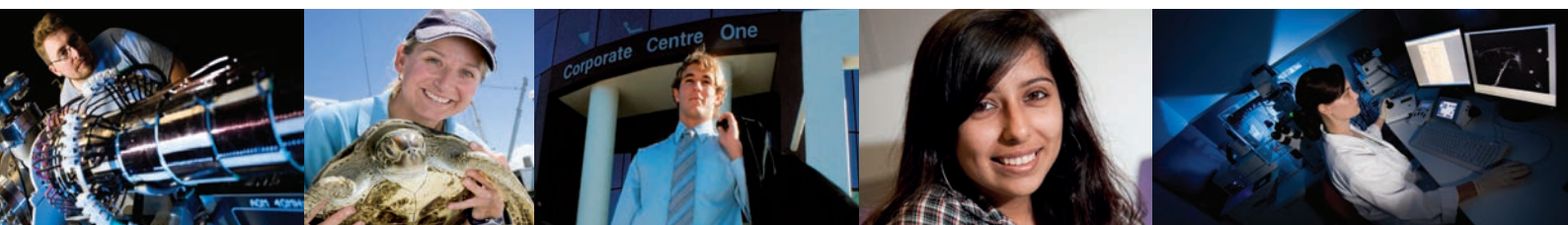

### Griffith on the move

- > 2011 Griffith's MBA was ranked number one in Australia and 26 in the world by the Aspen Institute's 2011- 2012 edition of Beyond Grey Pinstripes.
- > 2011 Griffith is among the world's leading younger universities and is ranked in The Times Higher Education - Top 100 of institutions under the age of 50; as well as the Asian QS Rankings - Top 50 under the age of 50.
- > 2012 Griffith University is placed in the top 500 global universities based on two of the major and most credible university world rankings: Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) and the QS World University Ranking.
- > 2012 Griffith is currently undergoing a \$320 million capital investment into upgrading facilities across its 5 campuses including a new AUD\$150 million Griffith Health Centre at the Gold Coast.
- > 2013 A new AUD\$1.76 billion State Government funded Gold Coast University Hospital is currently under construction adjacent to Griffith's Gold Coast campus, due for completion in 2013.
- > 2014 A new AUD\$1.8 billion world class Rapid Transit Rail Project will be constructed to link the Gold Coast campus with the city's CBD retail and restaurant hubs including Surfers Paradise and Broadbeach.
