## Intensive English Program

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The IEP is a full-time program featuring four eight-week sessions during the academic year and one eight-week session during the summer. Sessions start in August, October, January, March and June. Classes are offered at six levels, from Elementary to Academic Preparation Course. Students spend approximately 20 hours per week in class, taking courses in grammar, reading, listening/speaking, writing, and academic preparation. The program is flexible, and every effort is made to meet individual student needs.

The successful completion of the highest level of the Intensive English Program (Academic Preparation Course) is the equivalent of a 79 TOEFL score and may be substituted for the TOEFL requirement upon approval by the academic department.
