English Language Entry Requirements and Pathways

Students whose native language is not English must generally demonstrate their proficiency by achieving a score in a test such as Academic IELTS, TOEFL or Pearson (PTE Academic) (see table below). Other English language tests may also be accepted as proof of English language proficiency. Students who have successfully completed two years of full-time study in which the language of instruction was English may satisfy the English requirement. Students who successfully complete an English language course packaged with a JCU degree at the James Cook English Language Centre or approved pathway provider can gain direct entry to most JCU courses.
