

ACP REQUIREMENTS

- A minimum score of:
 - 71 on the iBT TOEFL,
 - 530 on the PBT TOEFL,
 - 685 on the TOEIC,
 - 6.0 on the IELTS,
 - or other evidence of advanced English language proficiency

Students who enroll in UCI's Intensive ESL must successfully pass all Level 5 courses to be eligible for an ACP

 Substantial academic or professional experience or university degree

Internship experiences are available following successful completion of an ACP.

TEFL Internships are offered within UCI's own Intensive ESL program.



Internship experience includes:

- Dedicated one-on-one support and advising
- American resume and cover letter development
- Interview skills training and mock interviews
- Internship research
- Explore new career options
- Networking and professional communication
- American work experience
- Exposure to American business culture

OPTIONAL PRACTICAL TRAINING (OPT)

Full-time, salaried position for up to one year on your student visa

- After 9 months of full-time study in one or more ACPs, including an internship experience, students may be eligible for OPT
- Program offered through U.S.Citizenship and Immigration Services

Employment on OPT must be relevant to the most recently-completed ACP

OPT: Students eligible to work in paid positions for up to 12 months

Designed for highly-motivated students to experience the academic and cultural life at a Top 10 public university campus with American and international students.



INTERNATIONAL SUMMER PROGRAM

For international students looking to enhance their resume or university applications by taking UCI undergraduate-level courses focused on project-and skill-based learning. Available in 2-, 4-, 6-, 8-week sessions.

- Students must be at least 18 years old

Learn the course topics that target critical and analytical thinking and resume writing and interviewing skills.

- Specialized Track (2 quarters)
 - Intentional curriculum for students who wish to pursue science and technology as their major area of study and future career; enroll in major-specific courses to acquire advanced academic, research, and professional communication skills and to fulfill the pre-requisites for application to a graduate degree program
- ➤ 3+1+1 Data Science & Data Analytics for Business Track (3 quarters)

HOW TO APPLY

Applying to our programs is easy!

- 1. Contact IEC Online GmbH they'll assist you with your application if you currently live (& study) in Germany, Austria, or Switzerland: www.ieconline.de, info@ieconline.de
- In the application process, IEC will submit your application documents and initiate your \$200
 application fee payment.
- 3. If you need an I-20 to apply for an F-1 student visa, a copy of your bank statement must be dated within the past 6 months and show funds available for the minimum amount required for your program. The bank statement must be in English and provide the balance amount in US Dollars.
- 4. Some programs require additional documents such as a copy of your English proficiency test score, high school or university degree, or official academic transcripts IEC can tell you what is needed!

Once your application has been processed and you have been accepted, we will send your I-20 along with our F-1 Visa Guide and Welcome Packet with directions for next steps and preparing to come to California!

*A tuition deposit is required for STAR and ASAP before receiving an I-20 and Letter of Acceptance.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application deadline is typically **one month** prior to the program start date. Applications received after the deadline will be considered on a space-available basis. Complete applications will be processed within one week. Incomplete information or missing documents will delay the application process.
