

UC SAN DIEGO EXTENSION INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS 2021

The information on these pages is considered accurate through December 2021, but dates and/or prices may be subject to change if UC San Diego campus revises its academic calendar or its fees for classes and facilities. All prices in this document are in U.S. dollars.

APPLICATION FEES

Application fees are non-refundable and must be paid before we can begin to process and review an application for admission to any program. Payment of an application fee does not guarantee admission or conditional admission to any program. All program acceptances depend upon the availability of space in the program, the applicant's qualifications for admission to the program, and the available time for processing the application and issuing acceptance materials in time for the student to arrange to come to UC San Diego.

Application fees are listed in this document for each program group:

- \$95 USD for online Business Certificate
- \$150 USD for English language programs (except youth programs)
- \$200 USD for all other programs

Application fees are per program start date:

Example: Each application fee applies to all of the programs within a program group as originally submitted on the application form. (For example, the student can apply for any one or more 2-week, 4-week, and/or 8-week ESL programs on one application form for just one application fee.) If applicants want to change to a different program start date within the same program group after submitting the original application form, please contact jpadmission@ucsd.edu with this request. Updated supporting documents may be required.

Students who attend a UC San Diego English program or certificate program and then return to their country or transfer to a different school must submit all required documents and application fees as new students if they want to return to a UC San Diego program.

Example: A student finishes a 4-week English program in October 2020 and will return to his country right after that. He decides that he wants to return for an 8-week English program in January 2021. There is a 4-week English program available in November 2020, but he does not want to continue on to that next-available program. He wants to skip that program and return to a later program. Therefore, he will be a "returning" student but he will not be a "continuing" student according to our enrollment records. Therefore, he must submit a new application form, the \$150 application fee, and updated supporting documents for the 8-week English program that will start in January 2021. We will issue acceptance materials and a new Form I-20 for the student to use in re-entering the United States. The student should meet with our Immigration Advisor to find out if he will need to apply for a new visa.

REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

Important: 30-day advance payment of tuition/fees and early purchase of UC San Diego Extension student medical insurance or submission of the Medical Insurance Waiver (MIW) Form is recommended to ensure smooth and timely completion of registration on the first day of the program. Incomplete registration and unpaid fees will result in delayed program attendance for the student. We recommend, if possible, that students schedule appointments for student visas after their acceptance materials and I-20s have been received.

Registration items to complete before program start date

Here is a list of all registration items which **students should complete 30 or more days before the first day of the published program start date** in order to avoid delays that might complicate their registration and program attendance:

1. Payment of full tuition (Please see the next page for payment procedures.)
2. Payment of International Student Services (ISS) fee
3. Payment of UC San Diego Extension medical insurance fee
4. TB Assessment form (ONLY for Certificate or University Credit programs, page A6 of the application form) sent to iphealth@ucsd.edu.

NOTE: We cannot accept early payment for textbooks. Students can pay for books **only** after they arrive and start their program at UC San Diego.

The following is a list of additional required items which the student must complete or show by 4 p.m. on registration day when he or she arrives at UC San Diego for the published start date of the program:

1. Completed address card to report local San Diego address
2. Physical passport
3. Form I-20

Do continuing students need to register again for their next program?

Yes, **all** continuing students must go to the International Student Services office, located at UC San Diego Extension Building E, before the last week of their program during the announced times in order to confirm all required registration items for the following program. **Due to COVID-19 and social distancing guidelines, in-person registration may change to online registration. Students will receive notifications by email if there are any changes.** There are no exceptions to this registration requirement. No matter what the students' enrollment or sponsorship status is, they **must** register at the end of one program session in order to continue into the next program session.

Government-sponsored students (such as Saudi Arabian students sponsored by SACM) must present a valid financial guarantee for the duration of the next program. All other students must pay the full tuition amount during continuing student registration and can get a full refund if they decide to cancel the program before the published program start date in the brochure and on our website.

Students with incomplete registrations (payments, medical insurance, immigration document check, submission/confirmation of local address) cannot attend classes, and they cannot receive their UC San Diego Extension student identification number (ID) cards. All registration items must be completed and confirmed on registration day in order for new, returning, and continuing students to begin their programs.

PAYMENT METHODS AND PROCEDURES

Advance payment advice

It takes 15-20 days for payments to be posted to a student's account. Payments made by credit card are sometimes delayed because of credit card limits.

Therefore, **we strongly recommend that students or their agent or university representative complete payment of all tuition and fees at least 30 days before their published program start date** to ensure timely receipt and recording of payment and the student's on-time attendance on the first day of classes. **Note:** For applications sent to us 30 days (or less) before the program start date, all tuition, fees, and documents listed in section H on page A1 of the application form must be submitted together with the application form.

Credit card payments

UC San Diego Extension accepts Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express, and JCB credit card payments. Please use the IP Online Payment Portal for credit/debit card payments. **IMPORTANT:** Do **NOT** email credit/debit card information to UC San Diego Extension, International Programs. Paying the Application fee and Express Mail fee (if applicable):

- **Step #1:** Submit a **complete** application to the IP Admission department by mail, email (ipadmission@ucsd.edu), or fax +1(858) 534-5703.
- **Step #2:** The IP Admission department will create the PID # (Student ID #) and email the following information to you:
 - Link to IP Online Payment Portal with instructions
 - PID # (Student ID #)
 - Amount to be charged in USD
- **Step #3:** Click on the link provided by the IP Admission department to enter the required information. Click on the submit button.
- **Step #4:** Once the IP Admission department receives the payment alert, the application will be processed for admission.

Bank wire payments

We can receive payment of invoiced tuition and fees by bank wire payment via Western Union Business Solutions online, as described in the following paragraph. However, please use a credit card, not bank wire, to pay the application fee and the express mailing fee. We do not accept bank wire payments for the application fee and express mailing fee.

The UC San Diego campus works with Western Union Business Solutions to provide our students and University Partners a safe and secure way to send a bank wire transfer from anywhere in the world directly to UC San Diego. Protecting our student's and partner's financial information is our #1 priority. For instructions on how to send bank wire payments using Western Union Business Solutions online, please email our finance team at ipfinancials@ucsd.edu. **NOTE:** Payments made by ACH transfers cannot be accepted because our campus General Accounting office cannot identify payments made in this manner.

Cash payments

For security reasons, please do not send cash through any kind of mail service.

Payment by traveler's checks

UC San Diego Extension accepts payment by traveler's checks. For security reasons, the student should not counter-sign the traveler's checks until the day of program registration.

INTERNATIONAL PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMS:

CONCURRENT TEFL CERTIFICATES

While enrolled in the six-month TEFL Professional Certificate program or the in-person portion of the TEFL Professional Certificate (Hybrid), students can choose Teaching English Grammar (TEG) courses/workshops or Teaching English to Young Learners (TEYL) courses/workshops in order to complete the requirements a concurrent certificate. This way a student can complete multiple programs and receive multiple certificates during their time in San Diego.

Additional courses for the TEYL and TEG certificates will be necessary in order for the student to meet the concurrent certificate requirements. Therefore, students will be required to pay additional course fees in order to complete a concurrent certificate. - After a student has been admitted into a TEFL program, a change to a different TEFL program requires the approval of the TEFL Program Coordinator.
- Students cannot change a program after the program has begun.
