

How to Apply for [BHGAP](#) Scholarship

Within the application, you will indicate your intent to apply for the [scholarship](#). You will need to submit an essay on the following topic:

Berkeley Haas students, faculty and alumni live our distinctive culture out loud by embracing our four Defining Leadership Principles: Question the Status Quo, Confidence Without Attitude, Students Always and Beyond Yourself. In 500 words or less, detail what these four [Haas Defining Principles](#) mean to you and how would you incorporate them during your time in the Berkeley Haas Global Access Program.

Professional or Academic Letter of Recommendation

In addition, please submit a professional or academic letter of recommendation. To obtain this letter of recommendation, connect with a colleague (such as a supervisor, manager or recent instructor) who can speak to your academic or professional capabilities. Once you have obtained the letter of recommendation, please ask them to email the letter to bhgap@berkeley.edu. Ask your recommender to include the following:

- Your full name
- The word "recommendation" in the email subject line
- Their professional or academic association with you in the body of the letter

Note that acceptable formats for the recommendation letter are MS Word or PDF.
